Vice President's Report: Erik Skogsberg

- A lot of focus during the holidays went to preparations for the visioning session which will be discussed under new business
- All feedback is welcome, there will be future sessions and meetings as well

Treasurer Report: Joe Rees

- As of November 30, 2023, SLOA generated a total income of \$364,800 which is \$17,311 above 2023 projections
- Total expenses are \$313,435 as of November which is \$2,682 below 2023 projections
- The balance of the reserve fund is \$199,818 with \$25,000 in expected expense by the end of December
- The RV lot has generated \$36,093 for 2023 income with a \$19,458 in expenses
- The RV lot reserve fund is at \$13,583

Architecture Report: Dave Walp

• There were 3 requests this month, 2 were for fences, and 1 for a deck replacement

Landscape Report: Nik Skogsberg

- A committee meeting will be held to discuss committee plans for spring
- A survey about landscaping has been made and will be sent out early this year
